## What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

Tonight's meeting has two basic goals:

1. We want to hear what your desires are for the study area so that we can truly understand what is important to you; and
2. We want to provide information about the West Wateree Transportation Study so that participants understand the opportunities presented by the project.

## Have decisions been made already?

Other than looking at existing conditions, the project team has not begun to consider solutions for the area; no decisions have been made. Your input during tonight's meeting will help the project team to determine what should be done. Please let us know what you like about the area and what you don't like about the area. This is your opportunity to help us know what is important to you.

## What happens after tonight?

In keeping with the two goals of tonight's meeting, the outcome of this meeting will be an understanding of the community's desires for the type, style, and character of transportation and adjacent development. Guiding principles (what's important to the community) will be identified, along with objectives to enable the project to remain true to those principles. Those guiding principles will be coupled with technical analyses to begin development of alternative solutions. Reviewing draft guiding principles will be the subject of our next public meeting on May 19th at 6:00 PM at Elgin Town Hall.
